Thank you for choosing our Wailea Ekahi Village condo. Access to this page generally confirms that we have received final payment for your stay. Should you need additional information, I am always available via e-mail at mcavoys@hasson.com or by phone at 503.816.6969.

ARRIVAL: *Check-in is 3 pm or later.*

As a courtesy to our caretaker, please don't arrive earlier unless prior arrangements have been made with owners. If there is a chance that you may be arriving after dark, it would be helpful to have a small flashlight with you to better see the lock box and walkways.

Condo access:

Your condo key will be found in the lock box on the front door.

To open the box: (if you make a mistake, press the Clear button and start over again)

1. Press in the four numbers of your code. These numbers may be entered in any order.
2. Once you have entered the numbers, PULL DOWN, then OUT on the OPEN BUTTON and remove your unit key. To insure maximum security and privacy, do not return it to the lock box until your departure. (As a convenience, we do tend to keep ours in the lock box during our stay in event that we do not have a key with us)
3. To close the lock box, repeat steps 1 and 2 again.

Guest Services:

The Ekahi office does not provide guest services. We have an excellent caretaker on island as well as a handyman available for our guests. Please contact Linda or myself should you need assistance during your stay.

Complimentary wireless high speed access is provided for use with your laptop.

Please use a calling card or call collect for all long distance phone calls.

Use of a cell phone while on the lanai is inappropriate in our condo building setting. Respect for our neighbors is a top priority and cell phone conversations are easily heard in the adjoining units and buildings.

Ekahi Village Parking Permit:

You will need to register with and secure a parking permit from the Ekahi Village office located in Building 18B. If they are closed when you arrive, please register on the first business day thereafter.

DEPARTURE: *Check out time is 10 AM unless prior arrangements have been made.*

We often have guests arriving on the afternoon of a departure day and our caretakers do need the time to properly prepare the condo for the next guests. When possible, we do offer a half day rate for a late departure for guests who may be leaving on the red eye flights back to the Mainland.

Mahalo for taking care of these housekeeping details prior to your departure

1. Comments in the guest book are always appreciated by both owners and future guests.
2. Turn off all ceiling fans, lights and air conditioner.
3. If time allows, please take out the trash (especially the kitchen trash) and wash beach towels.
4. Empty digital wall safe and leave door open. (Available in 34D)
5. Close and lock all windows, sliders and doors.
6. Leave extra keys on kitchen counter and return key to lock box.

CONDO INFO: "The Nitty Gritty"

Please review the following information and print if you feel the need. Thanks in advance for being considerate guests in our Maui home.

Upon arrival, you will find a copy of the Ekahi Village rules in our welcome book. Please review and take particular note of the request to not hang towels on lanai railings.

Safety and Security:

We have provided the Ekahi Village office with your arrival and departure dates. Ekahi Security is aware of which condos are occupied on any given night.

For security issues during normal business hours, call the Ekahi office at: 808.879.2770.

As we say, "This is paradise, not heaven". In condo 34D we have provided a digital wall safe (use any 4 digit code of your choice) so that you have a safe place to store your wallet and other valuables when you are away from the condo. We recommend using it when you are heading to the beach or pool. Our caretakers charge a \$25 service fee for a safe service call. In addition to placing your valuables in the safe, please lock all doors and sliders when you leave the condo. Don't leave valuables in your rental car any place in Maui.

Be sure to empty the safe and leave it open upon departure.

Guest and Reference Books:

We have the **Maui News** delivered daily to keep you up to date on island news and events. Please do make a note of your favorite activities or restaurants in our guest book. Future guests do appreciate your thoughts and suggestions.

Cleaning, Supplies & Beach Equipment:

You will find the condo clean for your arrival with an initial supply of coffee, tea, paper goods, laundry detergent, bath soap, dish and dishwasher detergent as well as many spices and condiments. Mahalo for purchasing additional supplies for longer stays.

An ample supply of linens, full size washer and dryer, hair dryers in each bathroom, beach towels, sand chairs, boogie board and cooler are available in the condo for your use. You will find the kitchen very well equipped for dining at home. We also provide a grill on the lanai for your use. Thanks for cleaning it after each use. Take particular note to empty and wash the small aluminum cup that collects grease under the grill. Island critters are attracted to the fragrance of grill grease.

You may want to contact our caretaker to make arrangements for her to come in for a mid stay maid service at your expense. We provide cleaning supplies under the sinks and in the broom closet for quick cleaning during your stay. Tiny ants are a problem in any island climate so do keep food tightly wrapped and in the refrigerator.

AC and Noise:

A central AC is provided. Although we spend 3 months at Ekahi in the winter and never turn it on, we do realize there are times when the AC is a necessity. Please honor the Ekahi Village request to run on low only after 10pm. As you would at home, please do not run the AC when away from the condo or if doors or windows are open. During warmer months, closing the drapes and plantation shutters before you leave for the day helps keep the condo cool.

Be aware that noise travels easily. For instance, conversations on the lanai are easily heard on the lanais adjoining. Please be considerate of your neighbors!

If you anticipate making any noise that would not be welcomed by neighbors (especially any loud voices), please close front door and kitchen window. Don't assume your conversations are private!

Groceries:

Well, one of our very favorite places on island has to be Costco. Yes, the size of the item tends to be more than ample but the value is the best. Costco is located just off the airport grounds. They carry all of the items one tends to find at any Costco but also sell wine and spirits and things such as chocolate covered macadamia nuts and other island treats. You won't find gasoline at our Maui Costco.

In Kihei you will find 3 different grocery stores for quick shopping and smaller portions. Safeway, Foodland and Star Market.

Golfers:

What could be better than golfing in paradise? Maui offers some of the best in the world. As a guest at Ekahi, you will enjoy discount rates at the 3 Wailea Golf Courses.
